I undersigned, am a specialized teacher certified by the Ontario Ministry of Education in Canada, since October 1975.

I graduated with a B.A. from the University of Ottawa in Ontario in 1979. Since, I have completed a Specialization in Special Education and Oral Language. In September of 1982, I started a Master's Degree in Education at this same University.

I have taught in regular elementary schools for 4 years, after which I was employed by the University of Ottawa to teach at the 'Centre Jules-Léger', a residential, experimental center for children and adolescents who have learning disabilities. This center, financed by the Ministry of Education, is the only one of its kind in all of Canada.

During my three years at this Center, I taught Math, Motor Development, Music, as well as Written and Oral Language, to pupils between the ages of 10 to 18. My work included giving one workshop a month to the many teachers from various parts of the province attending the monthly sessions.

Although my studies in education included extensive psychology and pedagogical courses, none of them offered me such a clear and complete complete insight into human psychology and education as that of Bhagwan Shree Rajneesh.
