I am writing in support of Bhagwan Shree Rajneesh, a very distinguished Indian spiritual leader, presently in Portland, Oregon.

I am a physician - an experimental pathologist who has spent 3 years at the Mass. Gen. Hospital, Boston; U.S.A. (1956-1959) 4 years in Oxford (1959-1963) 2½ years at the University of Chicago Pathology Department (1963-1965) and have since been continuously in Cambridge firstly at the Dunn Nutritional Laboratory and presently in the Pathology Department, University of Cambridge. I am a Fellow of Churchill College, Cambridge.
