To Whom It May Concern,

I am writing to support the application of Bhagwan Shree Rajneesh for permanent residence in the United States.

I became aware of Bhagwan's teachings when I began to read his books and listen to his tapes in 1977. At that time, I was a member of the Self-Realization Fellowship. In 1979 I became a "Sanyasin", I then went to India to visit Bhagwan. I spent three weeks at the Poona center, attending daily discourses, and participating in individual and group sessions for personal growth and therapy. I met personally with Bhagwan on two occasions.

I have been in the United States since 1958. In England I had a career in retail and hospital pharmacy, holding the dispenser's certificate of the Society of Apothecaries of London. In New York I was a research assistant in pharmacology at N.Y.U. Medical School, and obtained a B.A. degree from N.Y.U. After graduating from Albany Medical College I completed an internship at Pacific Medical Center and a residency in anesthesiology at the University of California, both in San Francisco. I have been in the full-time practice of anesthesia since 1971. I have been a citizen of the United States since 1964.

After 25 years of experience in the field of health care, I feel qualified to endorse Bhagwan's work in this area. He has brought together fine therapists from numerous specialities, who work

together closely, to guide people into a state of physical, mental, and spiritual well-being. I know of no other such inter-disciplinary center. The results achieved, in terms of the number of people helped, and the extent of improvement, have been astonishing and gratifying.
