I want to state

that I'm a Rajneeshi, a disciple of
Bhagwan Shree Rajneesh, and I've been
a Rajneeshi for the past 6 years.

I'm not a believer or a follower of
any doctrine or dogma, but a disciple,
which means I've seen my inner discipline
become apparent and grow. The presence
of Bhagwan, my master, has been of
unthinkable help and support in this
process of unlearning and unconditioning.

I have lived in the commune in Poona,
India, for almost two years and now I'm
living in a small commune in Heerde,

for a growing individual, for a discipline
