I, Edgar M. Miller, D.M.D., do hereby acknowledge and respectfully submit that:

I have been an active practitioner of dentistry from 1947 until 1978, with teaching positions at the post-graduate level from 1960 until 1975. I have raised a family of four delightful children, enjoyed more than 30 years in the practice of dentistry, been an active member of the community, the Masonic Lodge, Shrine, Elks, American Legion and the Democratic Party as a delegate to national conventions, served in the Army of the United States in both World War II and the Korean conflict, been awarded the Medical Combat Badge, the Bronze Star with Valour, the Croix de Guerre, the Korean Combat Ribbon with 3 battle stars for distinguished service with the 23rd Infantry Regiment.
