Since 1967 I studied at Giessen University in West Germany. 1974/75 I graduated in physics, mathematics and politics for being a teacher at college ("Gymnasium"). From 1975 to 1983 I taught at a large college in Giessen ("Herderschule"). Since February 1983 I am a teacher at Leuchtbergschule in Eschwege teaching preferably physics and mathematics.

Two years ago I came across Bhagwan Shree Rajneesh reading books by him.
