To whom it may concern,

I am writing this letter as support for Bhagwan Shree Rajneesh and the work that he is doing to help people better understand themselves and the world in which they live. My own contact with this is through his writing and through people who are involved in the many activities. In addition, my own work is influenced by many of the ideas and concepts about which he talks. This work is the training and development of managers in industry, commerce and government. In particular, it is the development of awareness, understanding and skills, to manage themselves and work effectively with other people. I have been doing this work for over ten years, and have been in contact with all levels of management in different industries and functions.

My understanding of Rajneesh is that he has wisdom and clarity of vision, and that he wishes to help others have the same. The way in which he does this, and the activities that he uses, are not essential in themselves, but are fitting to the age, and to what people can relate to.
